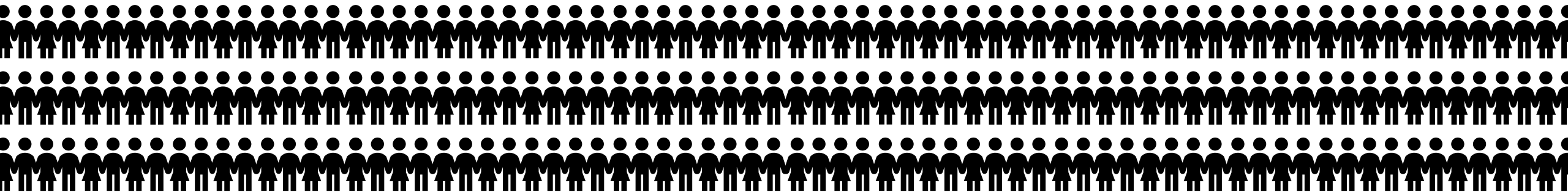
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Thesis to Tagline: Call for Participants

- Recruiting up to 6 national lab researchers
 - “Distill your research into tidbits for any audience”
- Requirements
 - Current or recent OE project with an authored **poster** at the 2026 energy storage review
 - Have a complete or near-complete technical paper, poster, or presentation
 - Must be able to attend all sessions
- Submission Details
 - Researcher statement: describe one thing people would find surprising about your research
 - Supervisor statement: describe how the nominee will be able to propagate “Thesis to Tagline” lessons to colleagues at the home lab
- Timeline
 - Email submission by August 21 5pm Eastern
 - Include both researcher and supervisor statements
 - Include both the title of the 2026 poster and the work to be used as part of the virtual coaching series (may be the same)
 - Send to esgc@hq.doe.gov
 - Send from PI email, carbon copying the supervisor providing the statement of support
 - Notification by September 3
 - Virtual Coaching Series (all times Eastern)
 - Sept 15, 22, 29; October 20, 27 (Tuesday 1-3 PM)
 - November 2 (Monday 11 AM)
